Preventive patient education

NaviCare may provide the following educational information to your patients and their caregivers:

- Reinforcement of healthy lifestyle changes, including the importance of having an annual health assessment, routine follow-up visits, taking medication(s) as prescribed, maintaining a healthy diet for weight management, following exercise recommendations, smoking cessation, and avoidance of secondhand smoke.
- Importance of an annual influenza vaccine.
- Importance of pneumococcal vaccines on or after 65th birthday, according to current guidelines
- Encouragement to discuss advance care planning with their doctor
- Required elements of a comprehensive annual health assessment, including:
 - Completed medication review/current medication list
 - Current functional status assessment
 - Completed pain assessment
 - Completed cognitive assessment as indicated

Clinical indicators

When evaluating your performance, Fallon will utilize the following indicators:

The percentage of your patients with:

- Evidence of an advance care plan or an annual advance care planning discussion
- Annual documentation of at least one medication review and the presence of a current medication list in the medical record
- Annual notation in the medical record that:
 - ADLs were assessed
 - IADLs were assessed
 - Assessment of at least three of the following:
 - Cognitive status
 - Ambulatory status
 - Sensory ability (hearing, vision, speech)
 - Other functional independence (e.g. exercise, ability to perform job)
- Annual documentation of a completed pain assessment
